**NOTICE TO THE PUBLIC ON ENVIRONMENTAL AND SOCIAL SAFEGUARDS
DISCLOUSER UNDER DAR ES SALAAM METROPOLITAN DEVELOPMENT PROJECT
(DMDP)**

The Government of Tanzania (GoT), with the support of the World Bank is seeking to increase the capacity of its urban local governments in Dar es Salaam and in the provision of urban infrastructure. This will be done through the Dar es Salaam Metropolitan Development Project. The proposed project will support Dar es Salaam in addressing its key urbanization challenges. It will focus on institutional development, including metropolitan governance, and strengthening of urban management systems. It will also include infrastructure investments for drainage, solid waste, roads, and urban upgrading. The project will likely be the first in a series of projects. The Project Management Office in the Prime Minister's Office - Regional and Local Government (PMO-RALG) is the government agency responsible for implementing the project preparation activities being carried out by consultants.

Consultants were engaged earlier in 2013 for preparation of the respective components and are now moving to final feasibility and detailed design stages. A total of 7 contracts for preparation of the 7 components have been awarded for preparation of the project. These are:

- 1) Institutional Strengthening
- 2) Infrastructure in Unplanned Settlements
- 3) Storm Water Drainage Improvements
- 4) Local Roads
- 5) Solid Waste Management
- 6) Rail and Marine Transport
- 7) Public Private Partnership Initiatives

To fulfill Design requirements, Environmental and Social Safeguard concerns have been considered as a cornerstone to support projects sustainability and provision for prevention and mitigation of undue harm to people and their environment in the development process. Either, a lesson learnt is that Environmental and Social Safeguards have shaped a conducive condition for various stakeholders to participate in

project design and building ownership among local populations
