Community Engagement Framework

PO-RALG has developed guideline that will guide LGAs intending to develop PPP projects. It is crucial for LGAs to engage community that will be affected by the Project from inception all the way to execution of the PPP projects. LGA's must design and resource community engagement activities from the earliest phase as projects are being identified and then continue to engage the community through construction and operation of PPP Projects. While this may have initial costs for the LGA, the long-term profitability of a PPP that has good community engagement will attract private sector partners.

Engagement is a two-way process, whereby, as much as we would like to listen to and take on board community input (s), so is to share information or inform communities about PPP activities. Engagement requires that project address issues and concerns and provide feedback to communities.
